Age 8 | Medical Condition: chronic lung disease, congenital heart disease

Eight-year-old Chloe may be smaller than her friends and classmates, but she is mighty and has a BIG heart. She loves reading and has sweet-tooth with her go-to desserts being ice cream and cheesecake. Her passion for animals is like no other - her favourite animal is a dog - and she aspires to be a vet when she grows up.

Chloe was born pre-maturely at just 24-weeks and spent much time in the NICU at Mount Sinai Hospital. Shortly after birth, she was diagnosed with chronic lung disease and transferred to Sick Kids to undergo surgery and recovery.





During her time at Sick Kids she was then diagnosed with various other conditions common in those being born prematurely including chronic lung disease, anemia, hearing impairment and others. Despite her diagnoses, undergoing multiple surgeries and years of treatment, Chole is doing better and continues to thrive.

Upon learning that her most heartfelt wish would be granted, Chloe knew immediately what would bring her hope and joy for years to come. Her very own four-legged furry forever friend. Growing up Chloe and her family had a black lab. The memories and bond they had is something that she looks forward to once again having, when her wish soon comes true.
