Campfire Circle programs are offered at paediatric hospitals across Ontario, in local communities, and at our medically supported overnight camps. Provided at no cost to families, these programs improve overall well-being, build self-confidence and resiliency, and foster much-needed connection and community with others who share a similar journey.

IN-HOSPITAL PROGRAMS

Our Program Specialists provide thousands of daily one-on-one bedside, group, or in-clinic camp-inspired experiences for newly diagnosed families, kids on active treatment, or during palliative care. These play-based sessions bring normalcy and connection to kids and caregivers during their time in hospital.

COMMUNITY PROGRAMS

Campfire Circle offers year-round medically-accessible programming for children, youth, and their families in their local communities. Available in the Greater Toronto Area, Hamilton, Ottawa, London, and Barrie, programs are inclusive of kids on active treatment

LEAH'S STORY

Leah, 13 years old, Cancer

Leah has always been an active kid who began figure skating when she was seven years old. One day during track and field, her knee began to hurt. Her parents took her to the doctors where physiotherapy was recommended, which Leah began. For three months she was going to routine physiotherapy until one day the doctor felt a lump and ordered an x-ray. It was after this x-ray that she was given the news that she had osteosarcoma, a type of bone cancer.

After her diagnosis, Leah felt very isolated from all of her friends. She couldn't risk getting sick so she had to stay home from school, resulting in her losing friendships. She underwent an intense chemotherapy protocol and eventually a rotationplasty – a surgical procedure removing part of her leg. Leah used a wheelchair to get around until she was fitted with a prosthetic. She hopes to one day become a prosthetist. "I WISH TO EXPLORE BANFF WITH MY FAMILY"

Leah's wish was inspired by all of her favourite things: spending time in the great outdoors, skating, skiing, hiking, and biking. She wished to go to Banff to explore the beautiful town with her family by her side. Leah and her family hopped on a plane to Calgary where they then got in a car and drove along the scenic route to Banff. "It was awesome," Leah shared. "We got to go to Alberta, go canoeing on Lake Louise, and the Banff Springs Hotel was my favourite part. They treated us so good everywhere we went."

Leah's wish to explore Banff with her family brought joy back into her life. They spent unforgettable days together exploring the beautiful outdoors and creating new memories. This trip wasn't just about adventure – it was a chance for Leah to reclaim her sense of wonder and hope.

The Mental Health Inpatient Unit features 32 inpatient beds. Courtyard access & bright windows provide a chance to enjoy nature during recovery.


EASING THE TRANSITION HOME

The Active and Daily Living (ADL) program lets patients practice daily life tasks, attend workshops and group therapy and get exercise.

INTEGRATED MOOD DISORDERS CLINIC

In partnership with Ontario Shores, patients can access innovative, non-invasive mood disorder treatments, such as brain stimulation.
